A Step-by-Step Guide to Using Nasal Spray

This guide provides step-by-step instructions for properly using a nasal spray. It includes preparation tips, correct technique, and aftercare to ensure safety and effectiveness.

Preparation for Use

- 1. Wash your hands with warm water and soap, then dry them thoroughly.
- 2. Check the spray bottle for expiration date or damage. Do not use if expired or damaged.

Using the Nasal Spray

- 1. Shake the bottle gently to mix the solution.
- 2. If it's your first use or hasn't been used in a while, prime the pump by spraying away from your face until a fine mist appears.
- 3. Hold the bottle with your index and middle fingers on either side of the nozzle and your thumb underneath.
- 4. Tilt your head slightly forward.
- 5. Gently insert the nozzle into one nostril while closing the other.
- 6. Press the pump as you breathe in gently. Do not tilt your head back or sniff forcefully.
- 7. Repeat in the other nostril.

Aftercare and Storage

- 1. Avoid blowing your nose immediately after use.
- 2. Clean the nozzle with warm water and let it air dry.
- 3. Refrigerate the nasal spray after each use.
- 4. Keep it out of reach of children and store securely.
